Brad Denning is a successful architect living a perfect life in Denver with his loving wife and son. Or so it would be, if not for the haunting memory of his brother Petey who disappeared while under Brad's supervision when they were kids. The positions are all from fairly recent games, so that the reader will not have seen them before in older puzzle books.
